



Water Usage

Problem: micro-plastics in our clothes

Solution: Laundry bags meant to filter and trap the micro-plastics inside (rather than in the ocean)

BACKYARD COMPOST


Select an area that is shady and cool to start, then routinely moisten the compost and add everything from clippings to food scraps!




LIGHTING

- **LED lightbulbs** are another money and energy-saving purchase (**75% less** energy!)

- Add motion sensing lights to the house to reduce unnecessary energy usage
- Post a sign under each light switch,
 "Turn off when not in use"

ALTERNATIVES TO TURNING UP YOUR HEATING AND COOLING SYSTEMS

- Before turning down your A/C, use fans as an alternative way to keep it cool
- **Keep** your thermostat at 78 degrees in the summer
- The optimal range for winter is between 68-72 degrees
- **Use** *ENERGY STAR* qualified programmable thermostats to regulate heating and cooling usage
- Remember to replace and maintain your HVAC systems if they are over 10 years old

- Buy from vintage shops and repurposing are cheap, unique, and eco-friendly easy to decorate a space
- Plants are an awesome way to fill an empty space while turning Carbon
